

Emergency management cycle

Comprehensive: encompasses all hazards, including **programs** for:

- 1. Forecasting/Prevention
- 2. Preparedness
- 3. Response
- 4. Recovery

Integrated: ensures the effort of governments, all relevant organisations/agencies and the community are coordinated.





THE TREATY ON THE FUNCTIONING OF THE EUROPEAN UNION - Article 196

The Union shall **encourage cooperation** between Member States in order to **improve the effectiveness** of systems for preventing and protecting against natural or man-made disasters.

Union action shall aim to:

- (a)**support and complement Member States' action** at national, regional and local level in risk <u>prevention</u>, in <u>preparing</u> their civil-protection personnel and in <u>responding</u> to natural or man-made disasters within the Union;
- (b) promote swift, effective operational cooperation within the Union between national civil-protection services;
- (c) promote consistency in international civil-protection work.





EU CIVIL Protection Mechanism actions



Prevention - to create an inventory of information
on disasters, share best practices, reinforce early
warning tools

Preparedness – to provide training programmes, exercises during simulated emergencies, exchange of expert's programmes, cooperation projects/modules on voluntary basis

Response – to provide search and rescue teams, medical teams, shelter, water purification units




Why companion animals??

- Protect public health (zoonosis, dog bites/aggressions, faecal contamination, garbage dispersion)

 - trapped, lost, abandoned or relinquished owned animals;
 - stray animals.

Seismic sequence






